

# A request to Fukui Residents regarding the Novel Coronavirus

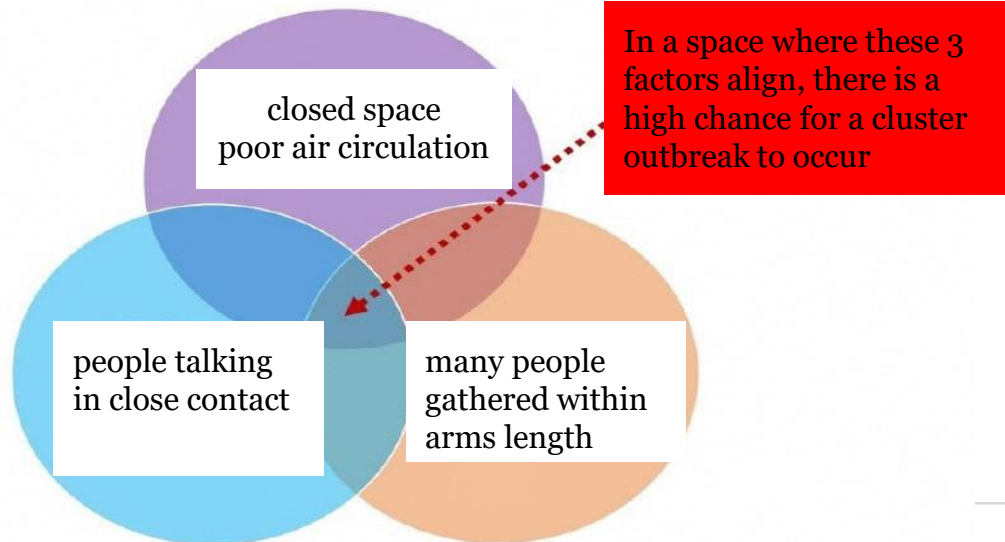
## Practice everyday preventive actions and take extra precautions if you become ill to prevent an outbreak in Fukui.

### Everyday preventive measures

- ◆ **Stay home** if you have a fever or cold-like symptoms.
- ◆ Regularly **wash your hands, use hand sanitizer, practice cough etiquette, and wear a mask when going outside.**

### Ways to prevent an outbreak

- ◆ **Avoid crowded places with poor air circulation.**



### If you are worried you may be infected

◆ If you are worried you may be infected, please take the following symptoms as a reference as symptoms that indicate the possibility of Coronavirus infection:

○ **Those feeling strong symptoms of sluggishness (fatigue) or difficulty (labored) breathing**

○ **Those with cold symptoms and a fever 37.5°C or higher that lasts for 4 days or more**

◆ Even if you do not fit the above symptoms, if you have a fever or difficulty breathing, **call your doctor to consult** before going.

◆ Those that meet the above conditions should **first call their nearest prefectural medical consultation center**. If you are instructed to go to a medical institution, **wear a mask** when going outside.
