Our students will have more time tomorrow. They are expected to build good relationships with their buddies and experience as much of the school life as possible without any hesitation.

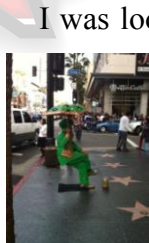
The second last day of the English classes
